



## TRACK A

Earn your Bachelor of Business Administration in Diversity, Leadership and Public Safety In 12 Months



### OVERVIEW

Cleary University and the Flint Police Department have partnered to offer Flint police officers degree-completion pathways to a Bachelor of Business Administration degree in Diversity, Leadership, and Public Safety. These pathways maximize transfer credits and build upon previous work and life experiences, police academy training, education, military service, and professional development to reduce the time and cost of a bachelor's degree.

### ABOUT TRACK A

Track A is an accelerated, 30-credit degree completion program that takes 12-months or less to complete. All courses are taken in a hybrid and online format meeting one night per week at a regional location or on campus at Cleary University. This track includes 18-week courses and 6-week courses.

### ELIGIBLE PUBLIC SAFETY PROFESSIONALS

#### EXPERIENCE

Track A is for officers who have 8+ years of work and life experience and 5+ of public service experience.

#### PROFESSIONAL, WORK, AND LIFE EXPERIENCE

This officer has taken advantage of numerous professional opportunities throughout their career and now possesses a large collection of professional development certifications and completion records.

#### TRANSFER CREDITS

An officer who has much less experience may also be eligible for this track if they have completed 60 or more college-level credits at an accredited college or university.
